You will learn how to piece two blocks and these two blocks are what make the whole quilt. Learn to strip piece and an easy way to cut from templates. By learning a few new techniques you will have mastered this quilt. There are **no** "Y" seams. You can do it.

### **Fabric:**

Orange with dots: 5/8 yard for pinwheels and diamonds

Orange solid: 1/2 yard for pinwheels and diamonds

Light gray print: 1 3/4

Dark gray solid: 1/2

White: 3/4

White with orange dots: 5/8

Turquoise: 1/2

Binding: 1/2

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### **Cut the following strips of fabric**

Orange with dot:

6 strips 1 3/8" x wof

3 strips 2 3/8" x wof

Orange solid:

4 strips 1 3/8" x wof

3 strips 2 3/8" x wof

Light gray print:

7 strips 7 1/2" x wof

Dark gray:

1 strip 1 3/8" x wof

2 strips 4" x wof

1 strip 2 1/4" x wof

White:

2 strips 1 3/8" x wof

3 strips 4" x wof

2 strips 2 1/4" x wof

White with orange dots:

2 strips 1 3/8" x wof

2 strips 4" x wof

2 strips 2 1/4" x wof

Turquoise:

5 strips 1 3/8" x wof

4 strip 2 1/4" x wof

Binding:

6 strips 2 1/4" x wof

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
