1 day class Supply List

Call in the evenings or on the weekends.

My sample has 100 different bright fabrics – you can choose 100 different, or different shades of one color, or scrap!

Equipment:

Sewing machine
Open toe or any regular sewing foot.
Knee lift if you have one for your machine

Basic sewing machine supplies
Nippers, straight pins,
4" x 4" piece of template plastic
Paper scissors to cut plastic
Ultra fine point permanent marker
Dark & light marking pencils.
Sand board if you have one (not necessary)

Notions:

A little more than ½ yd. warm & natural cotton needle punched batting -fit (2) 18" circles
½ yard fabric for the front and back of the pillow
use another ¼ yard of the same pillow fabric and cut 8 long bias strips 1 ¼" wide.
100 pieces 4" x 8" fabrics cut before class folded in half to 4" x 4" and ironed.

A few 8" x 8" to give you a few to choices for the center of the flower
A large button, some beads if you like

A piece of the newspaper – double page, this will be folded to make your 18" circle
Template. If you are allergic to newsprint, iron freezer paper together to get a big enough
circle. We will be making the circle in class. I will be showing you how to use a
yardstick compass also.

Threads:

Neutral cotton thread for top and 3-4 filled bobbins

A matching cotton thread for putting it all together

You will also need, but not in class, muslin and a bag of stuffing, I will show you how I
put it all together – my way!
