

Learn the techniques behind the Studio 180 Design (Deb Tucker) tool without committing to yet another project. In this class we'll investigate the Corner Beam & Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star tools while creating 4" units that you can mix and match to create your own unique blocks like those pictured. Once you master the basics of each tool, learn even more techniques to create stunning blocks. Although this is a technique class, all the units we create can be put together in unique blocks perfect for a special sample quilt.

The Corner Beam will add many unique options to your quilt designs. The combinations of twists and turns makes it look as if you had to work with lots of odd shaped pieces when in fact you didn't. The construction of a Sliver unit advances the use of the Corner Beam and once again makes precise piecing look so difficult!

Volcanos don't belong in the center of an eight-pointed star and they won't happen to you when you use the Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star tool. And, by the way, there will be no y-seams either! Be thoroughly stunned when you learn how to make a Lemoyne Star using a strip pieced method. You can make blocks as small as 3" all the way up to 12" with the same level of accuracy.

### Class Supplies

- Studio 180 Corner Beam & Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star tools - available for purchase at a discount from the instructor the day of class
- Technique Sheet: Sliver - included in \$20 class fee payable to the instructor the day of class
- Design Sheets: Corner Beam and Lemoyne Star - included in class fee
- Fabric for class - ½ yard focus fabric, ½ yard background fabric, ½ yard medium value fabric, ½ yard dark fabric - We will cut our fabric during class - no need to pre-cut prior to class.
- 6" x 24" Ruler, Cutting Mat (at least 12" x 18") & Rotary Cutter (with new blade)
- Sewing machine, Thread & bobbins, General sewing kit - scissors, pins, seam ripper, machine needles, etc.
