Level: Beginner Intermediate Advanced All Levels

Class Description:

Linked squares is an updated version of a quilt done by Nancy Cabot in 1930. You will only need to choose three fabrics. 4 simple pattern pieces make up the block. It goes it go together rather quickly, so you can have this quilt done in no time. The partial seam method makes block assembly very easy and a pieced border creates a nice scalloped effect frame for this quilt.

Approx. 73" X 96"

Fabric

Light 3 ½ yds. (background)

Med. 1 ¾ yds. * (this is one of the squares links)

Dark 4 yds. * (this is one of the squared links **and** the outer border)

Binding ½ yd. You may want to choose binding after quilt is complete

Yardage for medium and dark can be switched if you would like to have a medium outer border and a dark inner border. The choice is yours. I have made them both ways. It just depends on the fabrics you choose.

Supplies:

Sewing Machine & extension cord

Thread to blend with fabric

Scissors (for cloth & plastic)

Seam Ripper

Rotary cutter, mat & ruler

Iron & pressing board

Sharp pencil (mechanical)

Fine, or ultra fine sharpie to mark template plastic

Mylar (template plastic)

Small Sandpaper circles (to keep templates from sliding)

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PRE CUTTING – TWIN

BLOCKS – CUTTING -

***SEE BELOW DO NOT CUT FOR THE ENTIRE QUILT**

BACKGROUND (Light) As in model

(24) 4 ¾” squares

Cut (8) 7” strips WOF – sub cut into 7” squares (48)

LINKS: (Medium) As in model

Cut (10) 2 5//8” strips WOF

Cut (12) 4 ¼” squares

LINKS: (Dark) As in model

Cut (10) 2 5/8” strips WOF

Cut (12) 4 ¼” Squares

The above information is for cutting the entire quilt. I prefer that you just cut ONE (1) from each of the instructions so that we can make sure that everything is OK before going forward. That’s enough to get started and we can cut more in class. I don’t want any misunderstanding for the precutting and have all of your fabric cut incorrectly!
