

Clip and Flip Raw Edge Machine Appliqué - Blooming Blocks Class with Diane Califano

Class Supply List

Basic sewing supplies:

- Sewing machine, with power cord, pedal, bobbins, needle and owner's manual
- Thread, color to match each of the three fabrics
- Pins
- Seam Ripper
- Scissors - Shears and Thread Snips

Additional sewing supplies:

- Scissors (suitable for cutting appliqué pieces, i.e. smaller than shears and bigger than thread snips)
- Sewline Pencil (or other temporary marking tool of choice, but not one that disappears with heat)
- Open Toe Foot (optional but preferred)
- Personal/Table-Top Light box (optional)
- Miniature Appliqué Iron and Pressing Mat (optional)

Fabrics: Refer to Pre-Cutting Instructions

- 1/2 yard of light fabric (class sample uses an off white multi-color print)
- 1/2 yard of medium fabric (class sample uses orange)
- 1/2 yard of dark fabric (class sample uses dark green)
- 1/2 yard of heat-n-bond Lite (or other glue transfer paper)

Fabric Yardage to make entire quilt: Just in case you plan to make the entire quilt I am providing the total yardages of fabric; however, this is not required for the class. You will only need to bring the above listed fabrics to make one Blooming Block in class.

- 1 3/4 yards of background fabric (class sample uses light green)
- 1 1/3 yard of light fabric (class sample uses an off white multi-color print)
- 1 1/2 yards of medium fabric (class sample uses orange)
- 2 1/4 yards of dark fabric (class sample uses dark green)

Plus:

- 1/2 yard fabric for Binding
- 4 yards fabric for Backing
- 70" x 70" of Batting
