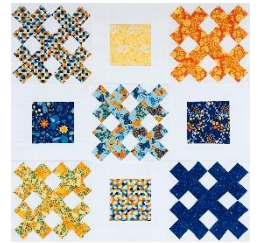


Criss-Cross Applesauce – A Layer Cake Quilt

Supply List:

- Sewing Machine in good working order with a quarter inch foot. (If you have a straight stitch throat plate, please bring it.)
- Your favorite sewing machine needles for piecing (I use Quilting 80/12 or 90/14).
- Basic sewing supplies: pins, scissors, seam ripper, stiletto, long ruler, ect. Bring reading glasses if you need them.
- Rotary Cutter with sharp/new blade. Cutting Mat at least 12" square. A rotating mat works great.
- 10 inch or larger Square (I like Creative Grids).
- 2- 1 gallon zip top plastic bags and Wonder Clips to organize fabrics.
- Neutral thread for piecing.
- Fabric
 - 1 Layer Cake or other collection of 10" squares with 42 pieces. OR you may cut your own 10" squares from 20-40 coordinating fabrics.
 - Background Fabric – 3 yards for Throw, 4 ½ yards for Twin, 5 ¼ yards for Queen Size.
 - Contrasting Border and Binding – 1 yard for Throw and Twin, 1 ¼ yard for Queen.
 - Wide Outer Border (queen size only) – 2 ¼ yards.
 - Coordinating Fabrics (queen size only) – 4-8 additional 10" squares to complete cornerstones in border and to substitute for fabrics in collection.



Homework:

- If not using a Layer Cake or other 10" square collection -- Cut at least 42 10" squares. The more fabrics you include the more interesting your design.
- Background Fabric – for class bring at least
 - 16 2 ½" x 9" rectangles
 - 16 2 ½" x 5" rectangles
 - 16 2" x 8" rectangles
 - 24 3 ½" squares
 - 16 2 ⅛" squares

Over achievers (you know who you are) -- Bring the rest of your background fabric.
