



# Radiant Star Quilt

## Fabric & Tool Supplies

1. Gradient or rainbow fabric – A jelly roll or from yardage select 4 fabrics that are at least ¼ yard each.
2. 1 yard, contrasting coordinating background fabric
3. Batting at least 42 inches square
4. 1 ¼ yard of fabric for the back
5. Binding – four strips 2.5 x WOF
6. A rectangle ruler with a 45-degree line or a Binding

## Cutting & Preparation Instructions

### Jelly roll or yardage cuts

- From the jelly roll select 4 fabrics, light to dark. Or from yardage cut two 2.5 inch x WOF strips for each of the 4 gradient or rainbow colors.
- Cut four 8.5 inch strips of each of the 4 colors, for a total of sixteen 8.5 inch strips
- Cut four 10.5 inch strips of each of the 4 colors, for a total of sixteen 10.5 inch strips



(Please note, because of limited time, the class Radiant Star will have only FOUR colors and is slightly smaller than the Radiant Star quilt at top of page, which has five colors. And the quilt above has two colors that are four shades of yellow and four shades of green, but remains a FOUR fabric Star. )

### Background fabric cuts

- Cut four 8.5 inch squares
- Cut four 2.5 inch X width of fabric (WOF)
- Cut four 9.5 inch squares, sub cut to 8 triangles by cutting each square corner to corner.
