## SEA GLASS

Sea Glass is a great example of something else you can do with a Diamond Rectangle unit besides of the usual Storm at Sea. Oversized units that are trimmed to perfection will result in a beautiful quilt that is sure to bring back fond memories of searching the beach for treasure. Choose a focus print, pull some coordinating fabrics from your stash, mix everything together with a light and a dark and you're headed for a great looking quilt. The finished size of this quit is 63" x 54½".

## <u>Fabric Requirements:</u> (Colors refer to pictured quilt)

Fabric	Yardage
Focus: border, binding (floral)	1 5/8 yards
Light Background	1 yard
Dark Background	13/8 yards
Coordinating Scrap Fabrics*	1¼ yards
Backing	4 yards

<sup>\*</sup>Fat quarters work well here.

<u>Pre-Class Cutting Instructions</u> (WOF = width of fabric, approx. 40")

Pre-cutting must be done prior to class to ensure maximum instructional and sewing time. There are many similar size pieces, so please keep them separate in labeled zip top bags or paper plates.





<u>Light Background</u> - Cut the following:

(80) 2 1/4" X 3" rectangles

**Dark Background** - Cut the following:

(24) 2" X 3 1/2" rectangles

(24) 2" X 6 ½" rectangles

(24) 5 1/2" squares

(4)  $10 \frac{1}{2}$ : squares

*Focus Fabric* - Cut the following:

(7) 6 ½" strips (outer border - not necessary for class)

<u>Medium Scraps</u> - Cut the following:

2 ½" strips (for diamonds - cut more strips for a scrappier look)

(20) 2 ½" squares (center squares for diamond blocks)

(52) 3 ½" squares (center squares for framed block and pieced border)

Some additional cutting will be required to complete the quilt.

## **Other Class Supplies:**

- Studio 180 Design Sea Glass Pattern
- Studio 180 Design Diamond Rects
- Invisi-Grip recommended for back of tools
- Fabric pre-cut for class see cutting instructions
- Cutting Mat & Rotary Cutter (with new blade)
- 6" x 12" and/or 6" x 24" Ruler
- Sewing machine, thread and bobbins
- General sewing kit scissors, pins, seam ripper, machine needles, etc.
