

Chic Country (aka Winding Ways)

Supply List

Required:

- Sewing Machine
- Neutral Thread
- Pressing Surface
- Cutting Mat
- 45mm Rotary Cutter (with a sharp blade)
- Rotary Cutting Ruler (at least 18" long)
- Pins
- Seam Ripper
- Stiletto (pointy thing for holding on to the end of your fabric as it goes through machine)
- Fabric Marking Pen/Pencil
- Spray Starch
- **Quick Curve Ruler**
- **Chic Country Quilt Pattern by Sew Kind of Wonderful**

Optional:

- Sew Square 6 Ruler by Sew Kind of Wonderful
- Knee Lift for your sewing machine
- Strip Stick (This is sometimes call a Seam Stick. It helps with pressing seams open.)

Fabric Requirements:

See Chic Country Pattern for Fabric Requirements. ***If you wish to increase the size of the quilt or use yardage in lieu of fat quarters, please email me.***

Optional Pre- Cutting

It isn't necessary but if you would like to do some cutting before class, I recommend the following:

1. Cut two fat quarters (one light and one dark) from your "Focus Flower" fabrics into 5" squares.
2. Cut two fat quarters (one light and one dark) from your background fabrics into the 4-1/4" x 6" and 4-1/4" x 6-1/2" rectangles as shown on Page 1 of the pattern under General Cutting. **Please note that the dimension for cutting the "background fabrics" is 4-1/4". This is somewhat unusual!**

I'm usually a big fan of starching your fabric before doing any cutting but in this case, we will starch after sewing the curves. I will have my favorite spray starch in class. If you have a favorite, be sure to bring it!
