Wall-Matters
Design, Painting, Fabric

The size of your precut Linoleum is 12" wide x 72", the perfect size for the soffit over a window. I have one in my dining room and one in my living room.



SUPPLY LIST:

Good Quality Paint such as: Winsor & Newton® Galeria Acrylic Paint, 6.75 oz.
This runs \$10.00, but keep your eye out for 50% off sales in AC Moore.
Since this will be hung on the wall, please use quality paint.

FABRIC OPTIONS:

In one of my pieces I used 1/2yd. of a large blossom fabric.
In the other piece I used my Electric Accuquilt Go Big® House pattern.
I will be bringing my dye cutter and house pattern, bring (8) fabrics prepared and/or if you have a dye you would like to use, please bring it and use my machine.
Prepared means fabric ironed and cut in 10" squares.
You can also bring trees, bushes walkway fabrics that can be hand cut and used in your wall Matters.

SUPPLIES:

A 4" quality paint brush (acrylic brush is perfect)
16 oz. Mod Podge® matte finish
(2) – 2" foam paintbrushes
(5-6) Paper towels
Plastic cup for water
Washcloth or small rag for your fingers
Clear wrap to cover work when you go to lunch

Throw away tray to spread the Mod Podge® about 10" x 14", (I used the top to a rectangular Rubbermaid container and washed afterwards).

Cookie Sheet to hold your cut fabric designs

Plastic drop cloth large enough to over your table and some flooring. Do not bring newspaper to work on.

Optional: Apron and gloves to use while painting.
