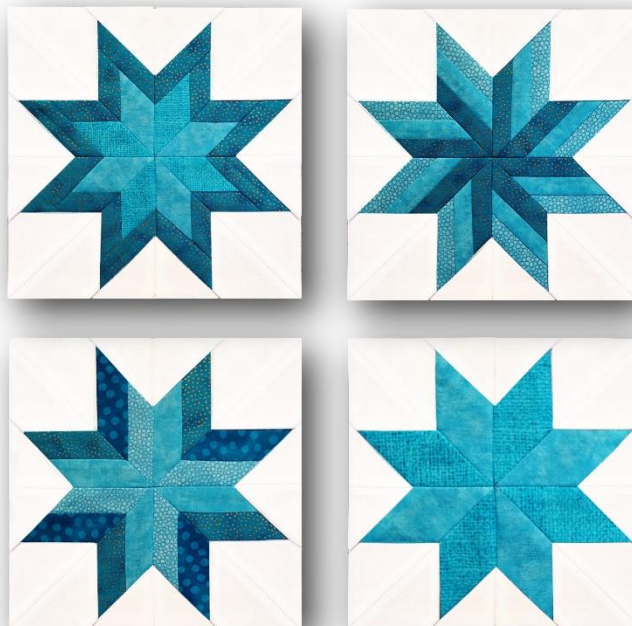

Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star Special Techniques

Volcanos don't belong in the center of an eight-pointed star and they won't happen to you when you use the Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star tool. And, by the way, there will be no y-seams either! Be thoroughly stunned when you learn how to make a Lemoyne Star using a strip pieced method. You can make blocks as small as 3" all the way up to 12" with the same level of accuracy.

Take your stars to the next level while exploring three special techniques: Strip Pieced Lemoyne Stars, Liberty Lemoyne Stars and Banded Lemoyne Stars. So, dig into your stash to find some coordinating fabric. Use all the stars you create in class for a great start to a sampler quilt or table runner. Fair warning, be prepared to become addicted to these techniques!



Class Supplies

- Studio 180 Design Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star Ruler – available for purchase on the day of class for \$32
- Design Sheet & Technique Sheets – included in class fee of \$25
- Fabric for class – Please come to class with fabric cut per the instructions. Label all fabrics.
- 6" x 24" or 6" x 12" Ruler, Cutting Mat & Rotary Cutter (new blade suggested)
- Sewing machine, thread & bobbins
- General sewing kit – scissors, pins, seam ripper, machine needles, extension cord, etc.



Pre-Class Cutting Instructions

Fabric identifiers are for organization only. Label all fabrics!

Lemoyne Star

- Fabric A – one 2 1/2" x 22" strip
- Fabric B – one 2 1/2" x 22" strip
- Background Fabric – two 3 3/4" x 22" strips

Strip Pieced Lemoyne

- Fabric C – one 1 3/8" x 22" strip
- Fabric D – one 1 5/8" x 22" strip
- Fabric E – one 1 5/8" x 22" strip
- Fabric F – one 1 3/8" x 22" strip
- Background Fabric – two 3 3/4" x 22" strips

Liberty Lemoyne

- Fabric G – two 1 3/8" x 22" strips
- Fabric H – two 1 1/16" x 22" strips
- Fabric I – two 1 1/16" x 22" strips
- Background Fabric – two 3 3/4" x 22" strips

Don't stress over the 1 1/16" strips, they just need to be a smidge over 1"

Banded Lemoyne

- Fabric J – one 1 3/4" x 22" strip
- Fabric K – one 1 3/4" x 22" strip
- Fabric L – four 1 1/4" x 22" strip
- Background Fabric – two 3 3/4" x 22" strips
