

# Quilting with Vintage Linens Dresser Scarf— Shannon Shirley

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We will begin the workshop with a trunk show of my work to inspire you with many ideas of what you can create with your vintage linens, then we will focus on working with dresser scarves for the day!

## Supplies:

Vintage dresser scarf  
Enough fabric for top, backing, binding etc.  
Batting (I use Warm and White)  
Thread for quilting, to match fabrics and linen.  
Blue water soluble marker  
paper  
pencil  
sharpie marker

24" ruler  
sewing machine, manual, cords, extra needles  
Basic sewing supplies

Optional:  
embellishments - rick rack, buttons, beads,  
embroidery floss  
lightweight fusible interfacing (helps in some cases)

You may choose to work on any vintage linen project you would like but will need to adjust the supply list accordingly. You may also bring additional pieces of vintage linens and blocks along if you want to play with ideas for future projects or piece multiple projects and quilt later.
