

Tulip Crowns – a Layer Cake Quilt

Supply List

- Sewing machine in good working order with quarter inch foot. If you have a straight stitch throat plate, bring it.
- Basic Sewing Supplies: pins, seam ripper, rotary cutter with a sharp blade, cutting mat and ruler.
- Reading glasses if you need them.
- Neutral thread for piecing.
- Square – 10” or larger.
- Studio 180° Magic Wand (optional).
- Fabric marking pen w/ fine point (Frixion or similar).



Fabric Selection Note – One reason this quilt was so successful is that all the prints in this Layer Cake (Moda’s Front Porch, 2018) were fairly small scale. There are a number of textures in each colorway but there are no overwhelming large prints. That allows the piecing to provide the pattern. Keep this in mind when you are making your selection. If your collection has large multi-colored prints, you may want to save them for the outer border. You’ll need to replace them with extra fat quarters in small scale prints. Also, I chose to use two different background colors, it would also look great with one background color.

Fabric Requirements -- (Assumes 42” of usable fabric width.) You can make this quilt as large or small as you want. Each block finishes at 16” with 2” sashing. One Layer Cake (collection of 42 – 10” squares) will make 9 squares and finish at 58” square with one narrow border (pictured at below). The quilt pictured above takes extra yardage, I used additional fat quarters and half yards from the same collection to complete my quilt. The yardage for the larger quilts includes enough for the pieced outer border. I’ve also included the yardage to enlarge this quilt to 92” square (4 x 4 blocks) if you are really ambitious!

Fabric for 9 block Tulip Crowns

- 1 Layer Cake or other collection of 42 – 10” squares
- Background Fabric -- 1 ½ yards for 1 color background OR ¾ yards of Each for two color background.
- Sashing – 1 yard
- Skinny Border (navy in photo) – ½ yard
- Binding – ¾ yard

Fabric for Larger Quilts

	<u>72 x 92”</u>	<u>92” square</u>
Layer Cake (42 – 10” squares)	1	1
Additional fabric– (consider multiple fat quarters to add variety)		
Leaves (green in photo)	1 yard	1 ½ yards
Flowers (pink, red, blue & white)	1 ¼ yards	1 ¾ yards
Background (1 color)	1 ¾ yards	2 ¼ yards
OR		
2 Color Background – from each color	1 yard	1 ¼ yards
Sashing	1 ¼ yards	1 ½ yards
Inner Border (1 ½” navy)	½ yards	½ yard
Outer Border (Pieced) background	1 ¼ yard	1 ¾ yard
OR		
Outer Border (Not Pieced)	2 ¾ yards	2 ¾ yards
Binding	¾ yard	1 yard

Precutting Instructions

Before class (for all sizes) – From Background Fabric cut:

1 – 6 ½’ width of fabric strips, cut into 16 – 2 ½” x 6 ½” rectangles

2 – 4 ½” width of fabric strips, cut into 32 – 2 ½” x 4 ½” rectangles

1 – 2 ½” strip, cut into 16 – 2 ½” squares

If using 2 different background colors, cut these from both fabrics.

Bring remaining background fabric to class.
