Class Name: Make a scene of trees combining hand embroidery with needle felting

Class Description: Using photos provided in class learn to embellish hand needle felting

In this class you will learn how to use the creative side of you brain to draw in threads and wool fibers, different varieties of trees and shrubs. No drawing ability is required. You will learn simple embroidery stitches, and how to needle felt, if you don't already know how to do them. What you are going to learn is the thought process involved to draw what you see in the photos, not what you think you see. I will pass out a basic instructional booklet with simple embroidery stitches with suggestions on how to employ them to draw trees, shrubs and flowers.

Additional Fees: \$25.00

Students will choose a hand dyed strip of wool fabric (each is one of a kind) three baggies of multiple colors of wool fibers with curls (like sheep grow).

I try to replicate grass/mountains/sky in one piece of wool...maybe even sunsetc and fibes. The fibers I dye are curly for more texture.

Students need to bring to class:

1. A felting tool
2. 2" thick foam block
3. Embroidery threads (pearl cotton threads will be available to purchase if you don't have them in your stash).
4. Needles
5. Small scissors



Both of these photos depict the different sections of the same wool strip which is 56" long x 6" high. The sheep are from the New Flock of Sheep pattern.
