

SOS – STRINGS OF SCRAPS

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All versions use strips of fabric cut in any width from 1 ¼” to 2 ½” wide in various lengths from 3 - 44 inches. Please have strips pressed flat. You may even want to swap scraps with fellow quilters. I will have some to share. We will be making samples of each. Then you may want to concentrate on a particular one.

FABRIC:

VERSION I - Approx. 60” x 75”

Outer border: 2 yds.
Inner border 1/3 yd.
Narrow (dark) sashing 5/8 yd.
Wider (light) sashing: 1 yd.
Small anchor blocks: 1/8 yd.
Large anchor blocks: ¼ yd.

VERSION II - Approx. 54” x 75”

Scraps as stated above

1½ yard fabric for corners (I chose black, but you may use whatever color you like)

VERSION III - Approx. 52” x 75”

Scraps as stated above making sure you have light medium & darks.

I have not given you yardage for borders on version I & III as I think they should be chosen once the body of the quilt is complete

VERSION V - Approx. 38” x 52”

Scraps as above plus ½ yd. for diagonals

SUPPLIES

Sewing Machine, extension cord

Extra needles for machine (larger needles are better #90 or #100)

Thread

Rotary cutter, mat, 6 ½" square ruler; 9 ½" square ruler , 6" x 24"

Glue stick

Spray sizing

Scissors, pins, etc. - General Sewing Supplies you normally use for workshops.
