

Lovely Lunch Bags

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Pattern: \$5.00 payable to instructor

Fabric: there are a wide variety of options to choose for your bag. You can use quilting cotton, a pieced block, sewable cork, vintage fabric, and much more as your bag body. Since lunch bags are small it is a great way to try experimenting with something new.

Outer Main: $\frac{1}{2}$ yard

Outer Bottom: $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

Lining: $\frac{1}{2}$ yard

You can include lace or trimmings if you want- you would need about 1 yard.

Other Supplies:

Sewing machine in good working condition

$\frac{1}{4}$ inch foot for machine

Walking foot

Size 80/12 sewing machine needles

Rotary Cutter with sharp blade

6 by 24" inch ruler- this does not need to be the exact width

6 inch square

14 inch zipper with plastic teeth- do not use metal!! You need two zippers in colors that work well with your bag fabric. Another option is to use a decorative button.

Craft Size batting- avoid 100% poly batting

Clips such as Dritz clips- you only need a couple of them

Pins

Fabric Scissors

Marking Pen such as Frixion

Thread for piecing- I use gray

Thread for top stitching- this should be something that works well with your fabric

Thread for quilting- something that works well with your fabric
