

# Mini Trees Supply List

## Required:

- Sewing Machine with 1/4" foot
- Neutral Thread
- Pressing Surface
- Cutting Mat
- 45mm Rotary Cutter (with a sharp blade)
- Rotary Cutting Ruler (at least 18" long)
- Pins
- Seam Ripper
- Stiletto (pointy thing for holding on to the end of your fabric as it goes through machine)
- Fabric Marking Pen/Pencil
- Spray Starch
- **Mini Quick Curve Ruler**

## Optional:

- Sew Square 6 Ruler by Sew Kind of Wonderful
- Knee Lift for your sewing machine
- Strip Stick (This is sometimes call a Seam Stick. It helps with pressing seams open.)

## Fabric Requirements:

See the free Mini Trees Pattern for Fabric Requirements. ***The pattern is for six trees with alternating background fabrics. If you would like to make an alternative layout that has more/less trees, more/less branches and/ or one background fabric, please email me for fabric requirements.***

Bring at least two 5" squares of scrap dark fabrics and two 5" squares of scrap light fabrics to practice using the Mini QCR ruler before cutting into your table runner fabric.

## Optional Pre- Cutting

It isn't necessary but if you would like to do some cutting before class, I recommend the following:

1. Cut (30) 5" squares from your dark fabric
2. Cut (30) 5" squares from your light fabric.

I'm usually a big fan of starching your fabric before doing any cutting but in this case, we will starch after sewing the curves. I will have my favorite spray starch in class. If you have a favorite, be sure to bring it!
