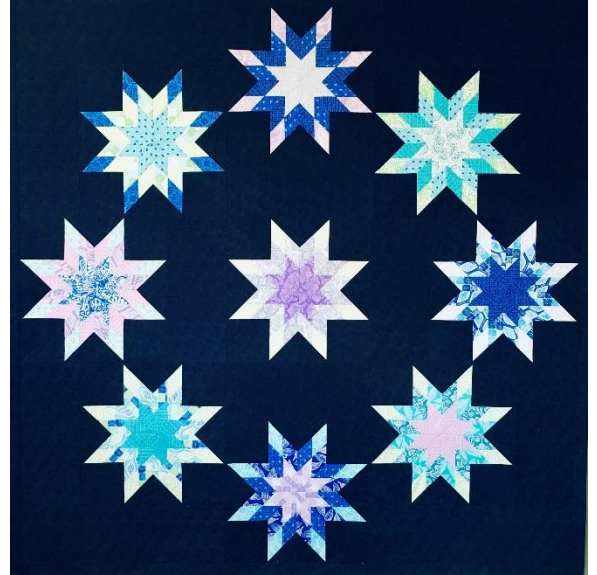


Star Circle – a Jelly Roll Quilt

Sewing Supply List

- Sewing machine in good working order with quarter inch foot. If you have a straight stitch throat plate, bring it.
- Basic Sewing Supplies: pins, seam ripper, rotary cutter with a sharp blade.
- Cutting mat (12" x 18" or larger) and ruler (18" or longer).
- Reading glasses if you need them.
- Neutral thread for piecing.
- Square – 10 ½" or larger with 45° line
- 45° Triangle Tool (Optional)



Fabric Selection Note –

Choose a jelly roll that has clear color groupings. Avoid large scale, multi-colored prints for this design. Prints that have similar tones work best. You'll need several designs in each color grouping for this to work well. Your background should have a good deal of contrast, so you don't lose the definition in the stars. This design uses 36 of the 42 strips, if a few of your strips are too close in color to the background, they can be set aside.

Fabric Requirements (Assumes 42" of usable fabric width)

- One Jelly Roll (or other 42 – 2 ½" strip collection)
- Background and border – 5 yards
- Binding – ¾ yards

Precutting Instructions

Before class, from Background fabric cut:

- 2 – 5" width of fabric strips, cut each strip into 5" squares (16 total)
- 2 – 7" width of fabric strips, cut each strip into 7" squares (12 total)

Pattern – Required pattern will be for sale in class for \$12, cash or PayPal.
