

MAQ 2019 Lottery Block

Nine Patch 'Straight Furrow'

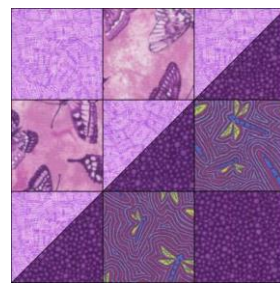
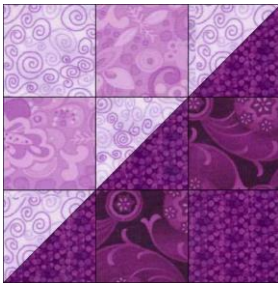
Finished size: 9" (unfinished 9 ½")

Fabrics:

Choose two groups of purple cottons (print, batiks, stripes, traditional or modern or mix it up). Fabric choices don't have to be completely purple, but they should 'read' purple. If you are not sure you have the right value of light or dark, use your cell phone to take a picture of fabrics you are considering. Edit the photo on your phone using a black and white filter. Use this to select fabrics for the 'light' side and those for the 'dark' side.

Group 1: Light to medium-light purple fabrics

Group 2: Medium-dark to dark purple fabrics.



For each block you will need to cut:

Using **template A** (or rotary cutting 3 ½" squares)

3 squares from Group 1 fabrics

3 squares from Group 2 fabrics

Using **template B**

3 triangles from Group 1 fabrics

3 triangles from Group 2 fabrics

Sewing:

Sew triangles together (pairing a group 1 fabric with a group 2 fabric) forming 3 squares.

Lay fabric out as in the picture.

Stitch pieces together to create a row. Repeat for next two rows.

Stitch rows together to form block.
