Dear Prospective MAQ Instructors,

The board of the Mid Appalachian Quilters is inviting you to submit proposals to become part of the faculty of MAQ 2020.

MAQ 2019 was attended by 331 quilters eager to learn and engage in the fellowship offered by fellow quilters. Interested in learning more about us? We are on the web: [www.maqonline.org](http://www.maqonline.org) as well as a Facebook group (MAQ - Mid-Appalachian Quilters).

MAQ Faculty members receive \$425 per day of class (6 hours of instruction). Meals and lodging are provided on campus. MAQ also reimburses instructors for travel and mileage expenses (up to \$500). Vending is permitted at no cost to you. Vending may be located in a central location this coming year.

Attached is a class proposal for the 33<sup>rd</sup> Mid-Appalachian Quilters Educational Symposium scheduled for Friday July 10<sup>th</sup> to Sunday July 12<sup>th</sup>, with arrival and set up on Thursday the 9<sup>th</sup>. Our annual event is held at Gettysburg College, Gettysburg, Pennsylvania. **Proposals must be received by October 1, 2019 to be eligible for consideration.** I recognize this is a short turnaround time, but hopefully you have ideas ready for our selection.

Please complete a separate proposal for each class - we encourage you send up to 5 proposals for review. If you are new to MAQ, consider submitting 1-day classes as we find that new instructors have difficulty filling multiple day classes. **Please submit each proposal as a word document.**

The MAQ board will meet in early October to determine class selections. Instructors will be notified of board decisions by the end of October.

If your classes are selected, we will request information to be included on our website (e.g.: biography, photo, class supply list, etc.).

Students who attended in 2019 loved the variety of classes offered. We had a range from hand applique and quilting, machine quilting with rulers and free motion, thread painting, ruler techniques and precut quilt patterns. We love to have classes for all skill levels from beginner to experienced. Some requests were for pattern making, EQ8 classes, scrap and stash busting quilts, Bargello, collage pieces, beading and embellishments, paper piecing, embroidery, and small projects (gifts, ornaments, totes).
