## Cracklin' Mats 101

Scrape up those vintage crumbs and play with Mary Kerr as she shares some of her favorite techniques for using up every scrap of fabric. This workshop encourages participants to showcase tiny vintage fragments that may seem too small to save. In a Southern kitchen, Cracklin's are those little bits of goodness that are left in the pan after cooking. Students may bring their own vintage fragments or they may purchase a kit of their choice in class. Finished sizes will vary.



Supply list:

Vintage blocks or top fragment: Bring those little bits that were too pretty to throw out. No precutting is necessary before class
¼ yard of coordinating solid cotton fabric
Thread to match or a neutral
Basic sewing kit to include scissors, ripper, rotary cutter and mat.
A square ruler is helpful but not necessary.
Sewing machine required

Vintage kits are available for \$20 and may be paid directly to the instructor. These will include enough fabric to create 3-4 small pieces
