Soak Up the Sun

Project size: 56" x 56"

Sunflowers symbolize loyalty and adoration thanks to the myth of Clytie and Apollo. And, because of their association with the sun, sunflowers are well-known for being a happy flower and the perfect bloom for a summer flower delivery to brighten someone's mood. If a single sunflower can do all that, just think what a quilt full of them can do for you!

Fabric Requirements: (Colors refer to pictured quilt)

8 fat quarters assorted yellow prints (flowers)

- 4 10" squares assorted greens (leaves)
- 4 fat quarters assorted gray prints (flower centers)
- 1 yard **EACH** background colors in light blue, light gray, medium gray and white
- 4 yards backing
- ½ yard binding





<u>Pre-Class Cutting Instructions</u> (WOF = width of fabric, approx. 40")

Pre-cutting must be done prior to class to ensure maximum instructional and sewing time. There are many similar size pieces, so please keep them separate in labeled zip top bags or paper plates.

Greens	Cut the following from EACH 10" square

	(5) 4½" x 7½"	Done in class
Backgrounds	Cut the following from EACH background fabric	
	(2) 5½" x WOF strips	(11) 5½" squares, (2) 4½" x 7½"
	(3) 4" x WOF strips	(29) 4" squares

Other Class Supplies:

- Sew Kind of Wonderful Mini Wonderful Curves book
- Sew Kind of Wonderful Quick Curve Mini ruler
- Dritz Seam Gauge (helpful, not required)
- SKW Sew Square 4 (helpful, not required)
- Stiletto (helpful, not required)

- 6" x 12" and/or 6" x 24" Ruler
- Cutting Mat (rotating if possible) & Rotary Cutter (with new blade)
- Fabric pre-cut for class see cutting instructions
- Sewing machine, thread and bobbins
- General sewing kit scissors, pins, seam ripper, machine needles, etc.
