Moon Dance Revival 60" x 60"

Fabric

(7) 1/3-yard cuts assorted warm color fabrics

(8) 1/3-yard cuts assorted cool color fabrics

1-yard gray fabric for accent strips

1/2-yard fabric for stars – brownish (a fabric from the ‘warm’ colors was used in the pattern)

(10) 1/3-yard cuts assorted low volume background fabrics

4 yards backing

1/2-yard binding

Have fun choosing your fabrics – warms and cools are just suggestions! A variety of fabrics works best.

General Cutting prior to class:

From each of (7) assorted warm (W) fabrics cut-

(1) 5" x wof, from strips cut (8) 5" x 5", for a total of (56) (there are extra to make design choices)

(1) 6 ½ " x wof, from strip cut (4) 6 ½ " x 6 ½ " squares, cut each in half diagonally, for a total of (56) assorted W triangles

(There are extras to make design choices)

From each of (8) assorted cool (C) fabrics cut-

(1) 5" x wof, from strip cut (8) 5" x 5" squares, for a total of (64) (There are extra to make design choices)

(1) 6 ½ " x wof, from each strip cut a total of (4) 6 ½ " x 6 ½ " squares, cut each square in half diagonally, for a total of (64) (There are extra to make design choices)

From gray (G) fabric cut-

(2) 5" x wof, from strip cut:

(10) 5" x 5" squares

(6) 4 ½ " x 4 ½ " squares

(2) 6 ½ " x wof, from strips cut (8) 6 ½ " x 6 ½ " squares -cut each in half diagonally

(2) 4 ½ " x wof, from strip cut (9) 4 ½ " x 4 ½ " squares

From rust (S) fabric for stars cut-

(2) 6 ½ " x wof, from strips cut (10) 6 ½ " x 6 ½ " squares, cut each in half diagonally

From each of (5) assorted background (Bg) fabric cut-

(1) 6 ½ " x wof, from strips cut (6) 6 ½ " x 6 ½ " squares from each for a total of (30) 6 ½ " x 6 ½ " squares, cut each in half diagonally

(1) 4 ½ " x wof, from strips cut (8) 4 ½ " x 4 ½ " from each fabric for a total of (40) 4 ½ " x 4 ½ " squares **from (1) assorted background (Bg) fabric cut-**

(1) 6 ½ " x wof, from strip cut (4) 6 ½ " x 6 ½ " squares, cut each in half diagonally, AND cut

(20) 2" x 2" for star centers from remaining strip

(1) 4 ½ " x wof, from strip cut (6) 4 ½ " x 4 ½ " squares

From each of (4) assorted background (Bg) fabric cut-

(1) 5" x wof, from strips cut (5) 5" x 5" squares from each for a total of (20) 5" x 5" squares

(1) 4 ½ " x wof, from strips cut (8) 4 ½ " x 4 ½ " squares from each for a total of (32) 4 ½ " x 4 ½ "squares

Label and separate each group of fabrics. I found it easiest to use Zip Loc bags and label by writing on a piece of paper and putting it on top of the fabric in the bag. If you have ANY questions or concerns don't hesitate to call or email me – I'm happy to help.



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
