## Lottery Block - Chandelier Block

All lottery blocks should measure 9 " or $81 / 2 "$ finished and contain quilt shop quality fabric. The center and corners will be a print fabric and the background fabric will be white on white print, please no solid fabrics.

Please color-test your fabric to see if the color bleeds. If there is some concern that the color will bleed prewash your fabric before using.

From the print fabric cut one 5 " square and $221 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, from the background fabric cut 2 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5$ " and 2 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 7$ ".


Sew a background strip $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5$ " to opposing sides of the 5 " square.

Sew a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square to the end of each $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 7$ " piece.


Sew these strips to opposing sides of the piece above being sure the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares are on opposite corners.

Press the block well.
For each block you make and enter you will get one entry into the lottery.

We will organize the blocks into groups and the winners will receive enough blocks for a lap-size quilt. In 2023 we awarded 8 packets of blocks.
