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Postcards From Santa Workshop

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Welcome to the Postcards From Santa workshop!

We will be making a 60" hexagonal tree skirt (or table topper if you can't bear to cut it) over the course of this two day workshop. You'll learn or perfect the Accordion Sewn HSTs™ method and should end up with an almost finished tree skirt with plenty of time to finish it before the holidays!

There's some pre-class homework – and maybe some shopping – to do, so let's go!



SUPPLIES NEEDED

- 3 1/2 yards main background (green in photo)
- 2 yards star background (white in photo)
- Approximately 1/2 yard total scraps of one color (20 different fabric scraps) for stars
- Fabrics as needed for your desired block shapes (more specific information is in the cutting directions in homework section), again lots of scraps of DIFFERENT fabrics within each color is what we are aiming for
- 3 yards backing (probably won't get to this part in class, but bring it if you have it)
- Batting and binding
- Basic sewing supplies
- Sewing machine with instruction booklet
- Piecing thread
- A couple of bobbins pre-wound with piecing thread is always a smart move
- Extra sewing machine needles
- One safety pin
- Half square triangle trimming ruler or template. I like the Clearly Perfect Slotted Trimmers, and they will be available in class.
- Other rulers – I am not picky about sizes. We will be squaring up to 14 1/2", which is a weird size. It's nice to have a 24" long ruler of some sort. Whatever you think you like for working with both larger and smaller pieces, bring them!
