

Wool Appliqué Sewing Case with Embroidery

Cost of kit: 68.00

Skill level: Beginner

Supplies needed: Scissors to cut the wool and embroidery thread. An embroidery book is helpful, but not necessary.

All other supplies needed are in the kit, or provided by the teacher the day of the workshop. The kit is to be ordered from www.Carriedawaydesigns.net, and includes the pattern, start up directions with photos, wool, all threads needed, chenille needle, freezer paper, and quilting paper. The Yazzi sewing case will be passed out to students the day of the workshop.

This project has been designed for someone new to wool appliqué, someone who wants to brush up on their embroidery skills, or someone who just wants to have fun creating this sweet little sewing case! Students are required to cut out the wool appliqué shapes and create a placement template, and whipstitch the appliqué shapes at home. Detailed directions with step by step photos will be mailed with the kit for the work which is required at home.

The pre-made sewing case will be available at the workshop.

Embroidery work will be done during class. Embroidery stitches used in this project are: chain stitch, lazy daisy, star stitch, seed stitch, French knot, featherstitch, fly stitch, fern stitch, double lazy daisy, back stitched chain stitch, stem stitch, twisted lazy daisy stitch.
