

# Supply list for Echo Star with Pinwheels

Strip piecing is the technique used in piecing this quilt. Learn how to create a pinwheel behind an eight pointed star. There are no inset seams so the quilt goes together in a hurry.

rotary cutter

rotary mat

rotary ruler (6" x 24")

thread to match

Pins

Scissors

Paper scissors

Sewing Machine with 1/4" foot

## Materials

Light green 1 yard

Dark green 1 yard

Gray 2 7/8 yard

## Pre-Cutting before class

Light green

- Cut 2 strips 2 1/4" x wof and cut in half.
- Cut 1 strip 5 3/4" x wof and cut in half.
- Cut 1 strip 10 3/4" x wof; subcut: 2 squares 10 3/4 x 10 3/4 and cut diagonally once for a total of 4 large triangle  
2 squares 7 3/4 x 7 3/4 and cut diagonally once for a total of 4 small triangles

Dark green

- Cut 2 strips 2 1/4" x wof and cut in half.
- Cut 1 strip 5 3/4" x wof and cut in half.
- Cut 1 strip 10 3/4" x wof; subcut: two squares 10 3/4" x 10 3/4" and cut diagonally once for a total of 4 large triangles  
2 squares 7 3/4" x 7 3/4" and cut diagonally once for a total of 4 small triangles

Gray

- Cut 2 strips 25 1/4" x wof; subcut; 1 square 25 1/4" x 25 1/4" and cut diagonally twice for a totl of 4 triangles  
4 rectangles 7 3/8" x 24 1/2"
- Cut 1 strip 7 1/2" x wof
- Cut 1 strip 4" x wof and cut in half.
- Cut 4 strips 2 1/4" x wof and cut in half.
