



My Neighborhood – A Quilt and Play Mat

Supplies Needed

- Sewing machine that straight stitches in good working order with cord and quarter-inch foot.
- Thread to coordinate with fabrics. I recommend black.
- Thread snips
- Add-a Quarter ruler, 6"x1" ruler/6"x6" ruler/6"x12" ruler
- Rotary cutter
- Small rotary cutting mat
- Pins

Fabrics

- 12-25 squares of quilting cotton cut at 7 ½ inches (see Preparation above)
- ½ yard of stop sign or other sign fabric for cornerstone blocks
- 1 ¾ yards solid black for roads and borders
- ½ yard of black and white striped fabric – stripes should be vertical or horizontal, not on an angle

Recommended

- Spray starch

Not included, but necessary to complete quilt:

- 3 ¼ yards backing fabric
- ½ Yard black for binding
- Batting 60 x 60 inches

You will need to purchase the Neighborhood pattern from the instructor for \$10.
