

Hopeful Flowers Wall Hanging Supply List

This floral wall hanging, is filled with a variety of unique stitches, and is a great start to embellished wool appliqué. Your stitch repertoire will grow as you complete each of the four blocks. This class will focus on basic wool appliqué and introduce some creative ways to use embroidery stitches to bring your appliqué to a new level. This would be a good introductory course for beginners but still challenging enough with new stitching applications for those with experience. Each student will receive a practice embroidery piece and practice thread. We will have wool kits available for \$15

Fabric

4 neutral cotton 9" squares for background
22" piece of cotton for backing
1 fat quarter for binding
6-12 fat eighths in colors that complement wool colors for border and sashing

Wool

4 colors of wool—4" x 5" (we used aqua, yellow, periwinkle, and rose)
green wool for leaves—4 1/2 "x 5 1/2 " (Optional wool kit available for purchase in class \$15)

Embroidery Threads

An assortment of #8 pearls and flosses to coordinate with wool flower colors.
Green #5 pearl cotton for stems (We used two different colors of green)
Pearl cotton or quilting thread for quilting.
(We will have a variety of threads available for purchase)

Other Supplies

Fusible for wool (We use SoftFuse.)
Freezer paper
Sharp scissors
Paper scissors
22" square of batting
Preferred appliqué needle
Small embroidery hoop
Embroidery or chenille needle (We used a #26 chenille.)
Lightbox (optional)
