

Magic Stack and Whack Quilts – book written by Bethany S. Reynolds

Half Square Triangle Magic - Kaleidoscope Pinwheel

Wall – 50" x 50" | Throw – 50" x 72" | Queen – 85" x 106"

Supplies

Large cutting mat, at least 24" x 24"

24" long Omnigrd Ruler (should be at least 6 ½" wide)

Rotary Cutter with a **brand-new** blade

Sewing machine in good working order with ¼" **capability**

Neutral thread

Box of Flower/Flat Head Pins

Scissors

Seam Ripper

Spray Starch or Best Press

Fabric Requirements

If the design repeat of the Main Fabric A is: The print should be a big bold print with at least a 7" repeat.

	7"-10"	11" - 14"	15" - 20"	21" - 27"	Over 27"
Wall	2 ½ yds	3 1/2	5	6 3/4	8 repeats
Throw	2 ½ yds	3 1/2	5	6 3/4	8 repeats
Queen	6 yds	6	6 1/2	6 3/4	8 repeats

Background Fabric

Wall: 2 yds

Throw: 3 yards

Queen: 4 ¾ yds

Accent Fabric (Inner Border)

Wall: ½ yd (binding)

Throw: 3/8 yd (border 1)

Queen: 1 3/8 yds (border 1 and 3)

Backing

Wall: 3 ¼ yds

Throw: 3 ¼ yds

Queen: 7 ¾ yds

Preparing to make this quilt – **DO NOT prewash your fabric.** Prewashing removes the sizing from the fabric and changes the warp and weft grains and makes it harder to create the kaleidoscope effect while making the quilt.

***Please note personal irons and freestanding sewing tables are not permitted in classrooms**
