Kawandi and Kantha are both stitching styles that have roots in Africa and have migrated through India and Asia

This is a Handwork Class

You will have a **choice of 2 different kits**, purchase of 1 kit is required

Payable to the Instructor in Class. Cash or Debit/Credit cards, No personal Checks Please!

BOTH kits include the fabrics needed for the Kantha Project. The difference between the kits is the amount of fabric included for the Kawandi Project

#1st Choice – Full kit, \$45.00

The full kit will include African fabrics and other coordinating fabrics to make a scrappy style Kawandi piece, approximately 18" square.

You will only need to bring general hand stitching items such as sharp scissors, a needle threader, thimble, or any other hand sewing item that you like to use when hand stitching.

#2nd Choice – Partial Kit, \$20.00

The partial kit will include only African Fabrics for the Kawandi project. You will need to bring a collection of scrap fabrics in a variety of colors – the scrappier the better. You will also need a Backing Fabric approximately 20" square. A piece of flannel or thin batting for a middle layer is optional. Please cut this about 18" square. You will also need to bring general hand stitching items such as sharp scissors, a needle threader, thimble, or any other hand sewing items that you like to use when hand stitching.
