Parfait Dyeing Supply List for MAQ

Fabric – 6 yards of cotton fabric. Please DO NOT use inexpensive muslin. It does not take the dye well. Purchase a high quality PFD (Prepared For Dyeing) fabric from a quilt shop, or online.

Cut or tear at least 3 yards of your fabric down into fat quarter sized pieces (a half yard, cut in half again to measure approx. 18"x22"). You should have 12 fat quarters ready before class. It is OK to precut all of your fat quarters ahead of time.

Rubber gloves – ones that come up your arm a bit (e.g. cleaning gloves).

A dust mask (N95) for dye and chemical mixing.

Scissors (if you haven't precut all of your fat quarters).

Four (4) plastic storage bowls to dye in. Look for somewhere around 48oz.size minimum. Check Walmart or the dollar store.

A Tablespoon and a liquid measuring cup and a plastic spoon. These can never again be used for food. Bring old ones that you may have or check the dollar stores or consignment shops for inexpensive ones.

A 5 gallon bucket for rinsing and transporting wet fabrics.

A portable drying rack if you already have one.

Paper & pencil for taking notes.

Wear old clothes – you will most likely get dirty. Bring an apron if desired.
