Project Size: 42" x 42"

Is a Quiltworx quilt on your bucket list? Cross it off with *Maple Leaf Flurries!* Join Julie, a Certified Instructor, as she guides you step-by-step through creating this beautiful wall hanging. Learn essential Judy Neimeyer techniques, including template layout sheets, cutting and stacking, registration points, and foundation paper piecing.

Bring your own pre-cut and labeled fabrics (see table below and page 2 for guidance). Foundation papers will be prepped in advance so you can focus on sewing and building confidence for future Quiltworx projects!



Fabric Requirements & Pre-Class Cutting Instructions

** This project is NOT suitable for fat quarters. **

** Use full width of fabric (42") strips. **

Color 1	3/8 yard	(4) 2½" x WOF strips	A2:a

Background 2 & Inner Border	5/8 yard	(3) 3" x WOF strips	A1:b
		(4) 2" x WOF strips	B1
Color 3	3/8 yard	(4) 2½" x WOF strips	A2:b
Color 4	3/8 yard	(4) 2½" x WOF strips	A3:b
Background 3	3/8 yard	(3) 3" x WOF strips	A1:c
Color 5	3/8 yard	(4) 2½" x WOF strips	A2:c
Color 6 & Outer Border & Binding	1 5/8 yard	(4) 2½" x WOF strips	A3:c
		Cut remaining fabric after piecing quilt top	B2 binding

Class Supplies

- Maple Leaf Flurries Pattern and Foundations – \$24 Julie will have necessary papers prepped for class.
- Fabrics prepped, labeled, and organized per the table above and the chart on page 2
- Add-A-Quarter Ruler, Sharpie Ultra-Fine marker, at least 20 large standard paper clips
- A 6" x 12" Ruler, Cutting Mat & Rotary Cutter (suggested with new blade)
- Scotch Repositionable Glue Stick (optional), Sewline Glue Pen (optional)
- Sewing machine in good working order, open-toe foot and ¼" foot
- General sewing kit – thread, scissors, pins, seam ripper, machine needles, extension cord, comfy cushion for your chair, chocolate, etc.
