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CLASS DESCRIPTION

This is An Intermediate/refresher class, perfect for the Sestercentennial. By the end of class, you will LOVE applique, Guaranteed! And be confident with templates, overlays, circles, curves, points, and Needle Turn Applique.

This is a 17" finished block.

The best part of this class is that you don't HAVE to bring ANYTHING!

Everything you need will be available in class to try and purchase if desired.

SUPPLY LIST: If you have the following items, please bring them. If you don't have them, please don't buy them - try mine first

- Scissors - one small pair that are sharp to the point
- Scissors - pair for cutting out pieces
- Roxanne's Glue Baste It
- Applique Pins
- Tweezers
- 1/4" Bias Tape Maker
- White chalk marking pencil
- Regular lead pencil
- Thimble (if needed)
- Heat Erasable Pen
- Task Light (like an Ott light)
- Extension Cord

FABRICS: (I will provide a kit, but you are welcome to bring your own if you like)

(4) 20" background squares – we will only need one for class

½ yard of red for wings, tail, and stars

½ yard of orange/gold for wings, tail, breast plate, and stars

½ yard eagle body color (dark green, blue, or brown)

½ yard darker shade of same color as eagle body for wings, tail, stars

½ yard medium green olive branches, fireworks and center leaves

Kit Fee is \$40.00 which includes: pattern, template material, overlay, appliqué needles, and thread, and all fabrics required to finish this block. Please contact me with ANY questions

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
