

Criss-Cross Apron With a Twist!

Another great reversible apron designed by Mary Mulari that has no strings or ties! Choose two different fabrics to match the wearer's personality & interests. OR, find an unfinished quilt top that is at least 36" square, add a coordinating fabric to make it at least 36" tall by at least 42" wide, plus more coordinating fabric (1 1/4 yards) to turn it into a fabulous, one-of-a-kind reversible apron!

Supplies Needed:

- Sewing machine in good working order that can sew a good straight stitch and an accurate 1/4" seam. New needle for your machine.
- One or two Spools of cotton thread in colors that match or contrast with your fabric choices.
- Basic Sewing Supplies, including pins, seam ripper, scissors for snipping threads, etc.
- Copy of Mary Mulari's Crisscross Apron Pattern (**required**)


Fabrics Needed for the Project:

- We recommend having 1 1/4 yards each of TWO fabrics (pattern says 1 yard of each).
- Optional: 1/4 yard of lightweight fusible interfacing for Pockets.
