

A native of the rolling foothills of Virginia's Blue Ridge Mountains, Kevin Womack is a textile artist whose work weaves together memory, tradition, and innovation. He began quilting in 1986, guided by his maternal grandmother, who introduced him to the power of fabric and stitch. Drawn to the stories held in cloth, he developed a lasting passion for exploring color, pattern, and texture. Over time, his devotion to fiber art led to a love of hand-dyeing and surface design. Kevin transforms plain fabric into vibrant works that balance quiet reflection with visual energy. His quilts have been exhibited nationally, including at Quilt National, Quilt Visions, and the Virginia Quilt Museum, earning honors such as Best in Show at Quilts=Art=Quilts 2021. A dedicated educator, Kevin teaches and lectures nationally.
