

Abby's Puzzle and Abby's Puzzle II – 6 hrs.

Abby's Puzzle is designed by Lynn Wheatley and inspired by the "Puzzling Personality" of her granddaughter Abby. This is a modern traditional quilt that combines the traditional piecing methods of Studio 180 Design and the curved piecing methods from Sew Kind of Wonderful. This design utilizes the Tucker Trimmer I™ tool from Studio 180 Design and the Mini QCR™ from Sew Kind of Wonderful.

- In class you will master the use of both specialized tools and many tips and tricks for curved and precision piecing.
- Depending on your speed of sewing, you should be able to complete a few blocks and start to lay out the quilt center.
- Abby's Puzzle has two different layout options: each with their own pattern. Abby's Puzzle features six fabrics and a background, while Abby's Puzzle II features two fabrics and a background. Block Size is 10 ½" finished.

Skill Level: Confident Beginner to Intermediate

Required Items:

 - **Pattern:** *Abby's Puzzle* or *Abby's Puzzle II* by Lynn Wheatley Design* **Fee: \$10 each or \$17 for both** - available to purchase in class, **cash payment preferred.**
 - **Specialty Tools:**
 - *Tucker Trimmer I™* by Studio 180 Design* available to purchase from Lynn at a 10% discount, *see ordering details below.
 - *QCR Mini Ruler®* by Sew Kind of Wonderful* available to purchase from Lynn at a 10% discount, *see ordering details below.
 - *¼" Marking Tool*, recommend *Quilter's Magic Wand™* by Studio 180 Design* available to purchase from Lynn at a 10% discount, *see ordering details below.
- **Precut Fabric – Pre-cutting is required for this class**, see page 2 & 3 for fabric requirements, selection guidance and minimum pre-cutting for class for each layout option.
- **General Items:**
 - Sewing machines with ¼" foot
 - Rotary cutter (new blade recommended)
 - Cutting mat 12" x 18" or equivalent
 - 6" x 12" Ruler or equivalent
 - Tweezers*** - very important
 - Neutral or matching colored thread (tan or grey)
 - General sewing kit –fabric marking pencil, scissors, pins, seam ripper, etc.

Recommended but not required:


- Invisigrip – a non-slip film for the backside of tools
- Strip Stick – pressing seams open
- Pressing Block – aides in flat seam
- Notebook, Pencil or Pen, and Camera




Abby's Puzzle – 6 Fabrics and a Background

When selecting fabrics, there should be contrast between Fabrics 1 & 6, and Fabrics 2 & 5. Fabrics 3 & 4 can be similar or different. I selected an Analogous color plan, green/blue/purple, but this would also work with a Split Complimentary plan, with Fabric 3 & 4 as an accent and across the color wheel from Fabrics 1, 2, 5 & 6. Just remember to check your contrast between Fabrics 1 & 6, and Fabrics 2 & 5. Any questions, email Lynn @ lynnwheatleyquilter@gmail.com.

Fabric Yardage:

Based on 40" of useable fabric with a few cutting errors. Please plan accordingly.

Minimum Pre-cutting for Class: this will allow you to complete 1 each of four different Blocks.

| Fabric 5 - Medium Shown in Green | QC4 | (1) 6" x WOF strip, sub cut into (2) 6" squares |
| | QST2 | (1) 5" x WOF strip, sub cut into (1) 5" squares |
| Fabric 6 – Medium Light Shown in Teal | QC2 | (1) 6" x WOF strip, sub cut into (2) 6" squares |
| | QST1 | (1) 5" x WOF strip, sub cut into (1) 5" squares |
| Background | HST1 & HST2 | (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip, sub cut into (8) 4 ½" squares Assign (4) 4 ½" squares to each HST1 & HST2 |
| | QC1, QC2, QC3 & QC4 | (1) 7" x WOF strip, sub cut into (8) 4" x 7" rectangles Assign (2) 4" x 7" rectangles to each QC1, QC2, QC3 & QC4 |


Abby's Puzzle II – 2 Fabrics and a Background

When selecting fabrics, there should be contrast between Fabrics 1, 2, and the Background. This can be created through color (Red and Blue) or by value (Dark and Medium Light). Any questions, email Lynn @ lynnwheatleyquilter@gmail.com.

Fabric Yardage:

Based on 40" of useable fabric with a few cutting errors. Please plan accordingly.

| Fabric | Wall/Baby 42" x 42" | Throw 64" x 64" | Double 87" x 87" |
|---|------------------------|-----------------------|-----------------------|
| Fabric 1 - Dark Shown in Red | 1 Yard | 1 $\frac{7}{8}$ Yards | 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ Yards |
| Fabric 2 - Medium Shown in Blue | 1 Yard | 1 $\frac{7}{8}$ Yards | 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ Yards |
| Background | 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ Yards | 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ Yards | 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ Yards |
| Binding - Quilters Choice | $\frac{3}{8}$ Yard | $\frac{1}{2}$ Yard | $\frac{5}{8}$ Yard |
| Backing | 3 Yards | 4 Yards | 8 Yards |



Minimum Pre-cutting for Class: this will allow you to complete 2 each of two different Blocks.

| | Quarter Curve 1 (QC1) | (1) 6" x WOF strip, sub cut into (4) 6" squares |
| Fabric 2 - Medium Shown in Blue | Half Square Triangle 2 (HST2) | (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip, sub cut into (4) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares |
| | Quarter Square Triangle (QST) | (1) 5" x WOF strip, sub cut into (2) 5" squares |
| | Quarter Curve 2 (QC2) | (1) 6" x WOF strip, sub cut into (4) 6" squares |
| Background | Half Square Triangle 1 (HST1) & Half Square Triangle 2 (HST2) | (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip, sub cut into (8) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares Assign (4) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares to each HST1 & HST2 |
| | Quarter Curve 1 (QC1) & Quarter Curve 2 (QC2) | (1) 7" x WOF strip, sub cut into (8) 4" x 7" rectangles Assign (4) 4" x 7" rectangles to each QC1 & QC2 |
